ARTICLE 6

Assessments

.4 Parments. Assessments and installments thereon paid on or before 5 ways after the day when the same shall become due, shall not beer interest but all sums not paid on or before 5 days when due shall bear interest at the rate-of-10-percent-per annum highest rate following late charges shall be imposed upon late payments: \$10 on any payment made after the 10th day of the month; \$15 on any payment made (after the 15th day of the month; \$20 on any payment made after the 20th day of the month. All payments on account shall be first applied to interest and late charges and then to the assessment payment first due. If any installment of an assessment be not paid on or before 30 days after the same shall become due, the board of administration may declare the entire assessment as to the delinquent owner then due and payable in full as if so originally assessed.

Restrictions

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.8 Leasing. After approval of the Association elsewhere required, the entire apartment may be rented provided the occupancy is only by one lessee and members of dis immediate family, his servants and guests, and the term of the lease is not less than 4 months twelve months. No rooms may be cented and no transient tenants may be accommodated.

A-unit-owner-may keep-a-cat-or-dog-(provided the dog will-not-weigh-more-than-10-pounds-at-maturity) <u>No dog</u>, <u>cat</u> or other pet shall be permitted on the condominium property at any time, provided that this restriction shall not apply to any pet in residence at the time of enactment of this restriction, pursuant to a properly issued pet registration agreement, although such pet upon its demise or loss may not thereafter be replaced.
